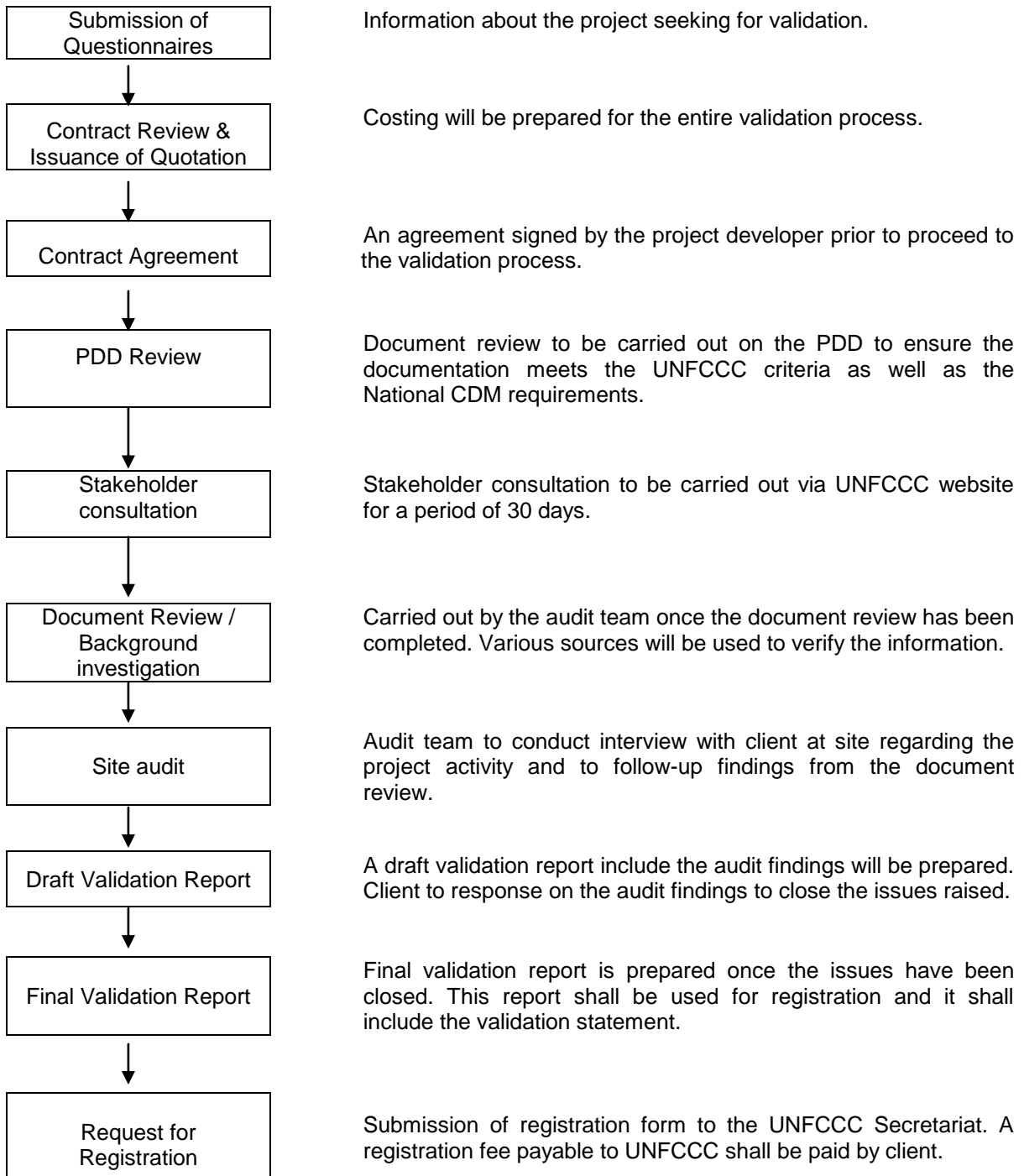


SIRIM QAS INTERNATIONAL SDN BHD GUIDE FOR CDM VALIDATION PROCESS

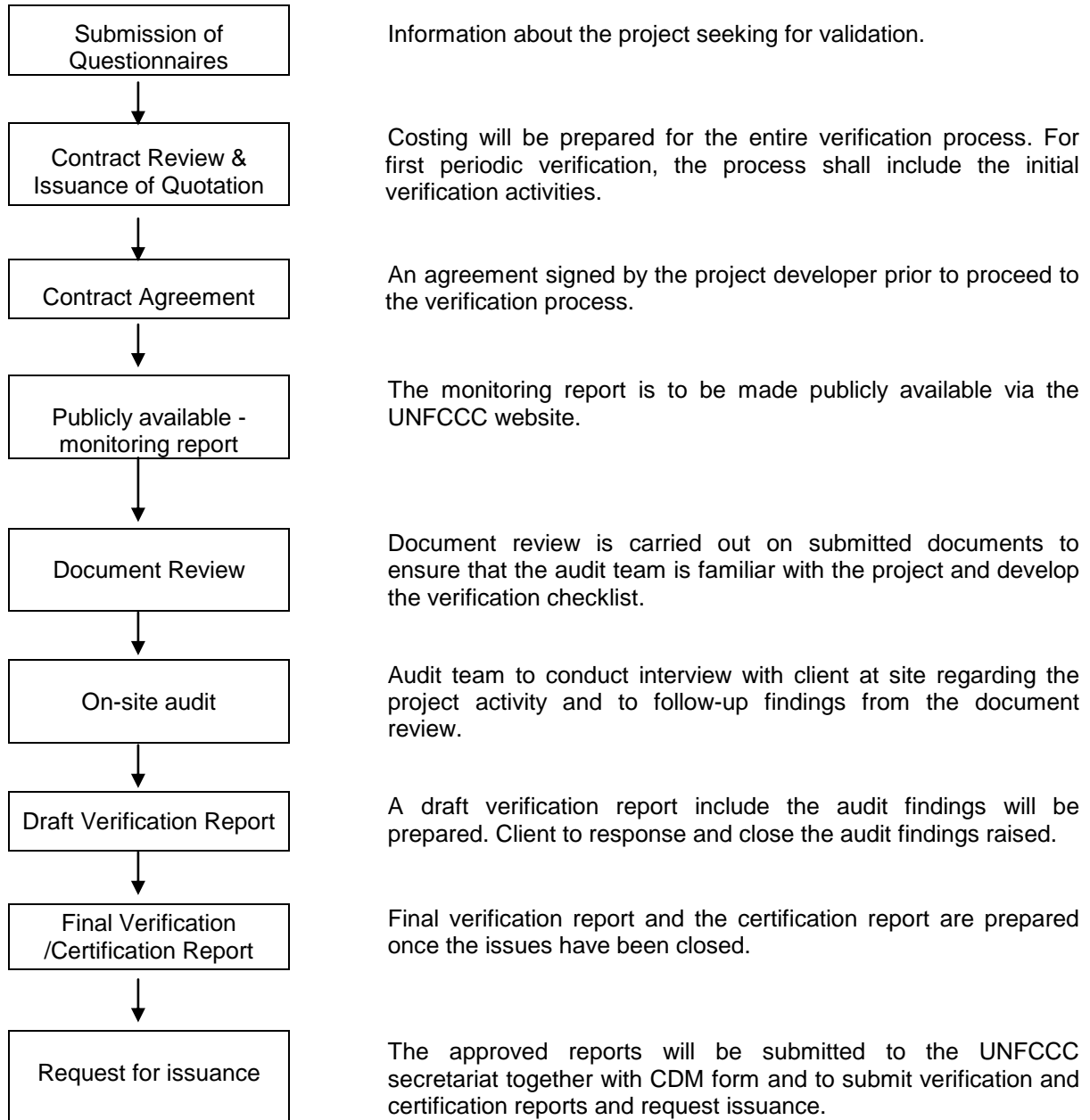
DESCRIPTION:

Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) is one of the flexible mechanisms under the Kyoto Protocol. It is a form of joint implementation between industrialized and developing countries. Under this mechanism, the Annex 1 countries can participate in the implementation of projects that reduce the greenhouse gas (GHG) emission in non-Annex 1 countries. The emission reductions achieved by the implementation of such projects as compared with the emission under a baseline scenario, duly certified, are treated as Certified Emission Reductions (CERs), which can be bought and used by the Annex 1 countries to comply with their emission reduction commitments/targets. Following are the steps for the validation and verification of a CDM project.

APPEALS PROCEDURE

The applicant may file an appeal when the applicant does not agree with the decision made by the Validation/Verification Team. The appeal shall be in writing and addressed to the Senior General Manager of the Management System Certification Department within 2 weeks of the notification of the decision.

COMPLAINT PROCEDURE

Any complaint about SIRIM QAS International certification services or about projects validated or verified by SIRIM QAS International shall be directed to Head of QOSHE Section or to the Senior General Manager of Management System Certification Department. All complaints shall be in writing. All complaints received will be verified and validated by the Head of QOSHE Section. Receipt of the complaint will be acknowledged and the complainant will be provided with progress reports on the investigation and the result of the investigation.
