2. Importers are required to provide designated quarantine area for the purpose of storage and demarcation from the rest of other goods to ease sampling process.
3. Importers are responsible to provide necessary tools/cutting equipment to facilitate sampling, carried out at company's premises.
4. During application of Temporary COA importers shall determine with agreement from SIRIM personal **proposed date** of consignment verification and sampling to be carried out.
5. Goods under quarantine are under the purview of Custom, thus Custom has the right to carry out further inspection, verification and other as provided by Custom Acts and the Law.
6. Goods which are found not to comply with Mandatory Standards or Custom requirements, eg. declaration and description will be confiscated by the Custom Authority and SIRIM shall not be liable for all the losses, incurred by the importers.
